Camp Keola Camperships The directors of Camp Keola are trying to make it possible for more young people to attend Mennonite camping at Keola this coming July. A fundraising campaign is underway. At our church we wish to support 10 youth at \$250 per camper (thus, a total of \$2,500) so that they can go to Camp Keola this summer. Mennonite Camping This Summer at Camp Keola This year our junior and junior high camps are July 8-14. The high school camp is July 15-21. The Mission and Service Committee is offering \$25 scholarships to children and youth from our church who do some Bible memory work. You can earn \$25 for memorizing Psalm 23, \$25 for memorizing Galatians 5:22-26, and \$25 for reciting the books of the Bible. You can recite any of these to members of the Mission and Service Committee (Gail Harder, RuthAnne Krause, Laura Zuniga, and Steve Penner).

Our "Safe Church" Commitment and Emergency Housing As part of our "safe church" commitment we committed ourselves to making a list of a few people in our church willing to offer their home as an emergency, short-term housing option for someone possibly facing deportation, or some other immigration related concern.
