**Baja Anabaptist Ministry Project** Over the past months Pastor Juan Montes, along with other Pacific Southwest Mennonite Conference people, has been involved in an Anabaptist Ministry Project south of the border in Baja, Mexico. They are working with Max Villatoro, a Mennonite pastor from Iowa, who was deported in 2015. Pastor Juan has been working with Pastor Max to plant a Mennonite church in Baja, a church that has a significant ministry with other deportees. Pastor Max has been separated from his wife (Pastor Gloria Villatoro) and their four children for these past years. Gloria plans to move to Mexico along with their three youngest children to be with Max in August. On her way to Mexico Gloria will be in Fresno. A united service will be held on Sunday morning, August 11, at 10:45 a.m. at Mennonite Community Church (5015 E. Olive Ave, Fresno) at which Pastor Gloria will be preaching.
