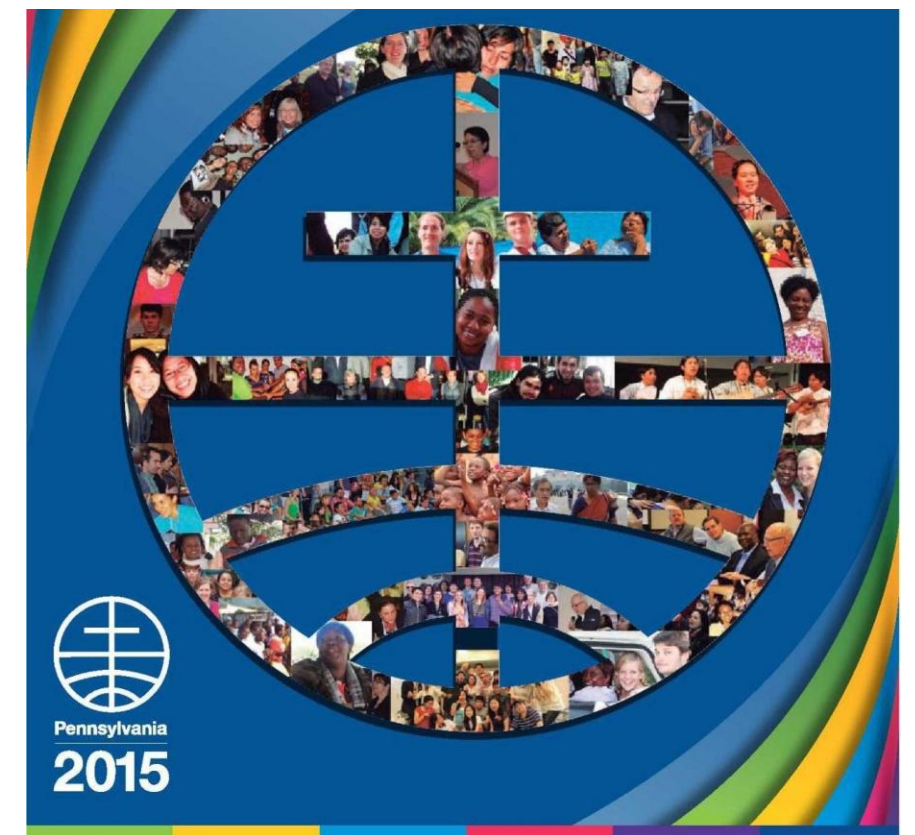

Today at First Mennonite Church The Anabaptist movement began on January 21, 1525 in a home in Zurich, Switzerland. That evening a group of brothers and sisters baptized each other and in doing so signified a deepened commitment to Jesus and a break from other Christian reformers, the Catholic Church, and the power of the state. Today, during our early service, we celebrate the global Anabaptist communion.

Our late service is meeting only in the Fellowship Hall today. Those who gather will take in two movies, one in the late morning and the other in the early afternoon. The film "Faith" will be shown first at 10:00 a.m., in Spanish at one end of the Fellowship Hall and in English at the other end of the Fellowship Hall. The second movie, about the power of prayer, is called "War Room." It too will be shown in Spanish and English beginning around 1:00 p.m. Surrounding the movies, there will be opportunities for reflection and food will be served.
