**Mennonite Church USA Convention in Kansas City** The Mennonite Church USA Convention begins this Tuesday and continues through the July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend. Ten youth from our church plus sponsors leave from the Amtrak station in Fresno today. They arrive in Kansas City on Tuesday morning and then, that same afternoon, head out to their "servant project" with Habitat for Humanity. The rest of the week will be filled with worship services, a spectrum of workshops, reflection times, and plenty of good times.

Meanwhile our congregation's three delegates (Joleen Siebert, Jose Mireles, and Steve Penner) will be sitting at tables of eight to hear reports, engage in dialogue, pray, and consider resolutions pertaining to various matters of faith and life. Juan Montes is also a delegate, representing Iglesia Menonita Hispana. Altogether there are over 700 delegates at the Convention.

We hold these meetings and all our congregational representatives in our prayers.

On Sunday evening, July 12, we plan to hear from various individuals in our church who attended Kansas City 2015.

**Next Sunday at our Church** Next Sunday morning Sharon Reimer will bring the proclamation during our early service. Dick and Karen Peterson will share during the "Care for our Beautiful World" moment and Karen and her daughter Amy will sing a duet to enhance our worship service.

During the late service Alexis Sandoval will bring the afternoon message. Our worship team will lead our congregational singing.

Tom Frantz will be the featured speaker and a panel will offer responses.
