**Border Learning Tour** A Border Learning Tour to the Mexico/Arizona border is scheduled for October 7-13. Participants will spend time on both sides of the border, visiting people addressing various humanitarian issues, conversing with border patrol agents, talking with prospective and recent immigrants, and taking walks in the desert.
