Relief for Nepal MCC is currently working on the details of our response to the 7.8 magnitude earthquake that has struck an area between the capital Kathmandu, and the city of Pokhara, Nepal. At this point we know that our initial response will include food and shelter support in remote areas. We have confirmed that all of our staff are safe and our buildings are intact. MCC is now talking to our partners in Nepal to further assess the situation, and we will provide more detail when it's available. News from Mary Raber Our church is supportive of Mary Raber, Mennonite Mission Network missionary in the Ukraine. Mary is involved in advanced theological training in the Ukraine. Mary recently defended her doctoral dissertation on "Ministries of Compassion among Russian Evangelicals, 1905-1929." She writes: "I got interested in it because I spend a lot of time with different church groups that are involved in working with homeless children, or rehabilitation centers for alcoholics, or care for the elderly. They always seem to assume that this is something new that Christians have been able to do since the collapse of the Soviet Union, but I got to wondering about what the historical precedents might be. I chose 1905-1929 because those were years of relative freedom and activity for evangelical believers, just at the end of the Russian Empire and the beginning of the Soviet Union. I found that Russians were involved in quite a bit. There were children's homes and 'rescue' work, kind of like the Salvation Army. This is all material that can be worked into teaching now."
