He joined the International Mission (IJM) and served on the legal team in their Mumbai field office which combats sex trafficking and forced prostitution. In 2012, he moved to Delhi to start Counsel to Secure Justice, an organization that provides legal support and restorative care to survivors of sexual harm. This past June, Jonathan transitioned to Fresno to serve as Consultant with the Center for Peacemaking at Fresno Pacific University. Jonathan manages the Center's program evaluation process and provides the Center strategic input. Jonathan is here with his wife, Syl, and 20 month old daughter, Diya Teresa.
